The Board chose to have Bachmeier Fencing for the fence construction at the Brinkman Bridge.

Robert Campbell, Grant County Fair Association President, and Jody Fuchs, Fair Board member met with the Board to discuss the upcoming fair and 2019 fair. The Fair Association has request \$20,000 in the County Budget to be allocated to the Fair Association. The Grant County Fair has received \$15,000 in previous years for costs to maintain the fair grounds and defray expenses for the fair. Commissioner Reinhardt moved and Stoller seconded to allocate \$15,000 for the 2021 Grant County Fair. Roll call vote- Reinhardt – aye, Stoller – aye, Zenker – aye. Motion carried.

Marty Meyer called in to discuss dust control. Luke Sprenger called in also. The Board has not approved dust control on any road in the County. Sprenger requested reduced speed limit signs be placed on the farm to market road. The signs will have a speed of 25 mph.

John Sauber, Sauber Engineering, met with the Board to discuss future projects.

Meeting recessed.

Chairman Zenker opened meeting on bid letting for 2020 Gravel Crushing and Stockpiling. One bid was received from Fischer Industries for \$5.90/cubic yard for 40,000 cubic yards, total bid being \$236,000. Stoller moved and Reinhardt seconded to award Fischer Industries the bid.

Preliminary 2021 budget for County General, Road and Bridge, Prisoner Care, Farm to Market, Veteran Service Officer, Extension Office, Historical Society, Custer Health District, Council on Aging, County Ambulance, Unorganized Road & Bridge, Weed Board, Water Resource District, and Grant County Soil Conservation District were approved. Mill levies for State Medical Levy and Southwest Water Authority were approved
